

CAI comments on IL Manager Licensing regulations

On June 15, 2011, CAI submitted comments to the Illinois Department of Financial and Professional Regulation concerning proposed regulations to implement the state's community manager licensing act. The draft regulations provided additional details on defining who would be covered by the Act, what types of credentials and education will be required of licensees and what fees would apply to the program.

CAI expressed support for the clearly drafted provisions defining a professional community association manager. However, CAI expressed concern on two areas in the proposed regulation. First, CAI noted that the \$900 proposed fee to renew a license expired for more than 5 years was too high and would discourage managers from returning to the profession. CAI also sought to clarify that professional managers could take advantage of online classes and recorded webinars in meeting the requirements of the Act. To read CAI's comments, [click here](#).
