

VIRGINIA COMMON INTEREST COMMUNITY BOARD APPOINTED; FIRST MEETING SCHEDULED

On August 28, 2008, Virginia Governor Tim Kaine announced the appointments to the Virginia Common Interest Community Board ("CICB"). Under the legislation passed this year by the General Assembly, the CICB is charged with developing regulations to implement the professional community manager licensing regime. The complete Board list may be found below.

The CICB will hold its first meeting in Richmond on September 4, 2008. The purpose of the meeting is to adopt policies to govern the Board and to begin discussions on implementation of the new licensing regime. The Board will also need to take action on the policies for businesses obtaining the provisional licenses that management companies will be required to obtain by January 1, 2009.
