Gives you a voice. The volunteer committee represents the approximately 294,000 Hawaii residents who live in Hawaii's nearly 2,000 community associations. Your donation saves you and your community association money by protecting Hawaii's homeowner and condominium associations from burdensome legislation.

Keeps you informed and involved. The Hawaii Legislative Action Committee organizes "grassroots" advocacy campaigns — letters, e-mails, phone, and social media communications regarding important issues related to community associations.

Tracks legislation that could impact community associations. In 2025, the committee reviewed 187 bills that directly or indirectly impacted community associations >> www.caionline.org/LegislativeTracking

Strengthens key relationships with lawmakers. By educating lawmakers, legislative and executive staff, and other organizations, as well as testifying, the committee helps advance issues facing community associations and influence the outcome of legislation.

Advocacy Successes. Hawaii's legislative session began on January 15 and adjourned May 2, 2025. Below are highlights from the 2025 Hawaii State Legislature:

HB 70/SB 253 - HI LAC supported these bills that increase transparency in condominium associations through the disclosure of financial information via budget summaries. HI LAC worked diligently with legislators to amend the bills in ways which made the most sense for Hawaii homeowners.

These bills affirmatively state that required budget summaries must be published alongside association budgets and contain all required information, rather than instructing the reader to refer to specific sections of the budget for information. Under this legislation, the summaries are now also required to contain information on estimated costs of fire and life safety equipment suitable to address a building fire. This also establishes standing for homeowners to seek an injunction to force compliance should the budget summary not be published.

Status: Successfully PASSED, awaiting Governor's signature. Effective immediately upon signature.
