



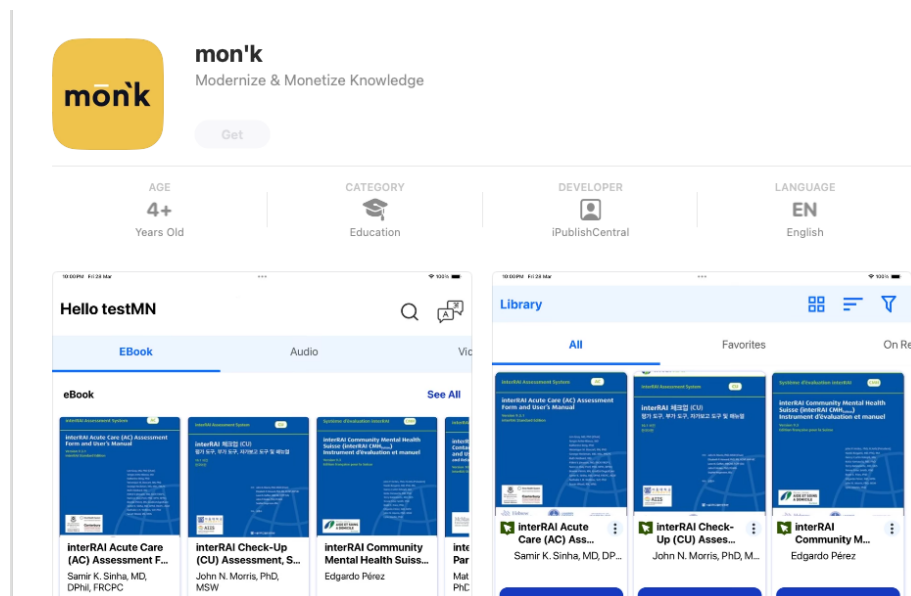

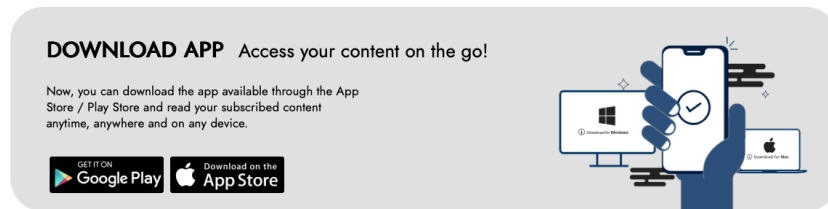
Whether you're reading on a computer or mobile app — online or offline — the new platform will give you the ability to access our valuable resources when you want and where you want.

What to know:

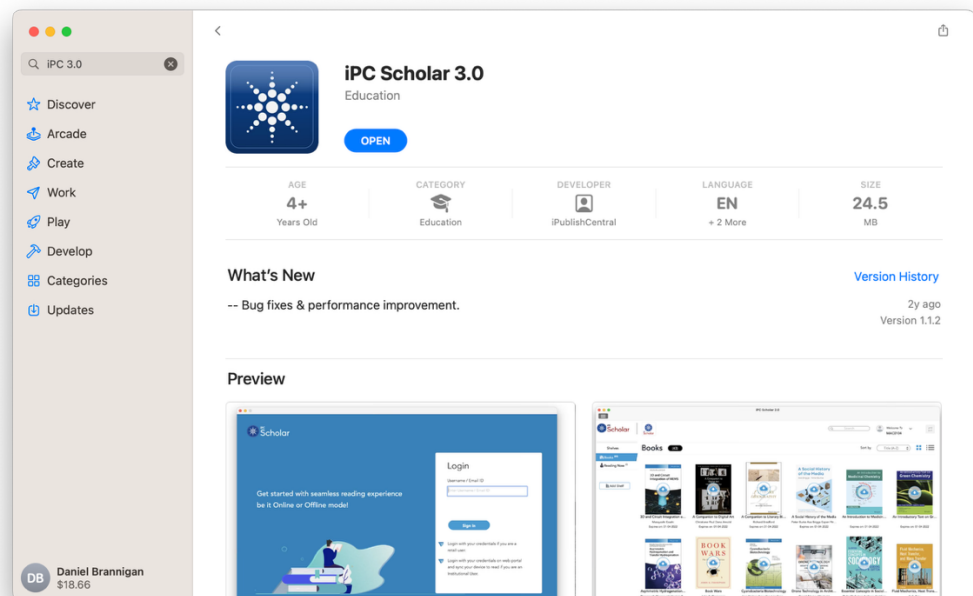
- Your books will transfer to the new platform automatically.
- You'll continue to access them on the web via ebooks.caionline.org.
- You'll continue to log in with the same username as www.caionline.org.
- The **mobile app** is changing from iPublishCentral Reader to Mon'k. Download the app:
 - **Now or after launch:** Visit your app store and search "Monk iPublishCentral." Look for the following icon:



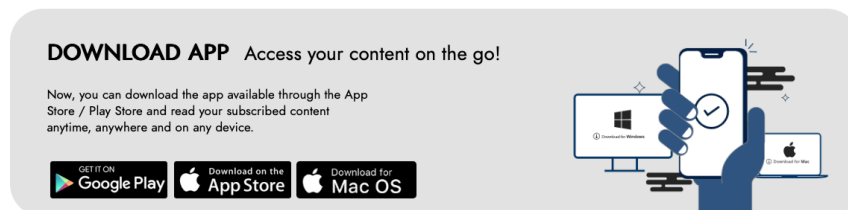
- **After launch:** Visit ebooks.caionline.org from your mobile device, scroll down, and click on the following for a direct link to the Mon’k app:



- The **desktop app** is changing from iPublishCentral eBooks Reader to iPC Scholar 3.0. Download the app:
 - **Now or after launch:** Visit your app store and search “iPC Scholar 3.0.” Look for the following icon:



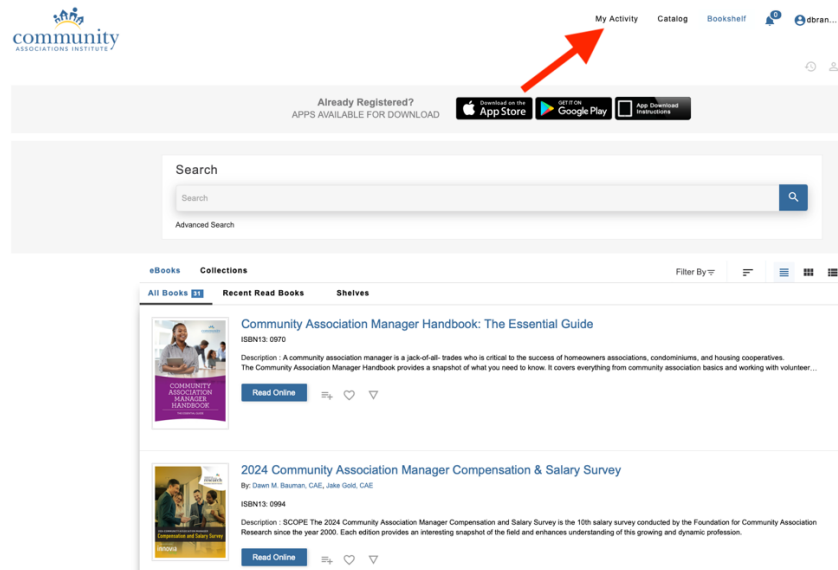
- **After launch:** Visit ebooks.caionline.org from your computer, scroll down, and click on the following for a direct link to the iPC Scholar app:



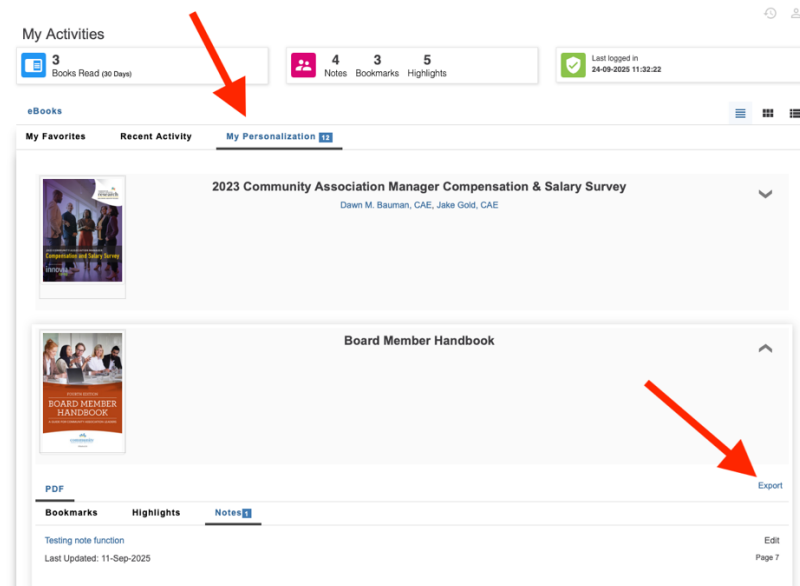
What to do now:

- Your bookmarks and notes in the current digital books platform cannot be transferred automatically to the new platform. If you’d like to save them, follow these instructions:

- Visit ebooks.caionline.org.
- Log in.
- Click on My Activity.



- Click on My Personalization.
- Click on the individual book(s).
- Click on “Bookmarks” or “Notes” then click “Export.”



- An Excel file will download to your computer. See individual tabs for bookmarks and notes. The list will include the page(s) where the personalization was made, the contents of the note (if created), and the date the personalization was made.
- Save the file and manually transfer when the new platform launches.

Please note: Bookmarks and notes have to be exported for each book separately. Highlights will not be exported unless they have a note attached to them.
